PERSONAL DATA

Our Privacy Policy aims to help you understand what information we collect and process using this website, how we use it and what choices you have about your personal data.

What Data do we collect?

Our website collects and processes information that you give to us, such as:

- Name and Surname
- Email address
- Telephone Number
- Online visits (cookies)

How we collect your personal data

We collect them through our communication with you. For example, data is collected from email correspondence with you or through face to face meetings, your linkedin, facebook, instagram or other social profile or through your company's website. Information can also be gathered by us when you submit a query through our website. Data is stored on email and in our client database systems.

What do we do with personal data that we collect ?

We process your data in connection with the management of our relationship with you for the following purposes:

- Improve our services
- Contacting you via telephone, email or post
- Administrative purposes in relation to the security of our IT systems, websites and applications
- Compliance with our legal and/or regulatory obligations

Why do we process personal data?

We will process your personal data before, during and after the end of the client relationship. We process your data to provide you with services such as, maintaining accurate and up-to-date client records and contact details, ensure effective business administration. Further, we process your personal data due to compliance with our legal obligations.

For how long do we keep data?

Your personal data are kept in our systems until you unsubscribe from our newsletter at any time you wish.

What are your rights?

Access and obtain a copy of your data on request

Require the organization to change incorrect or incomplete data

Require the organization to delete or stop processing your data, for example where the data is no longer necessary for the purposes of processing;

Object to the processing of your data where the organization is relying on its legitimate interests as the legal ground for processing; and

Ask the organization to stop processing data for a period if data is inaccurate or there is a dispute about whether or not your interests override the organization's legitimate grounds for processing data.

What Are Cookies

As is common practice with almost all professional websites this site uses cookies, which are tiny files that are downloaded to your computer, to improve your experience. This page describes what information they gather, how we use it and why we sometimes need to store these cookies. We will also share how you can prevent these cookies from being stored however this may downgrade or 'break' certain elements of the sites functionality.

How We Use Cookies

We use cookies for a variety of reasons detailed below. Unfortunately in most cases there are no industry standard options for disabling cookies without completely disabling the functionality and features they add to this site. It is recommended that you leave on all cookies if you are not sure whether you need them or not in case they are used to provide a service that you use.

Disabling Cookies

You can prevent the setting of cookies by adjusting the settings on your browser (see your browser Help for how to do this). Be aware that disabling cookies will affect the functionality of this and many other websites that you visit. Disabling cookies will usually result in also disabling certain functionality and features of the this site. Therefore it is recommended that you do not disable cookies.

The Cookies We Set

Login related cookies We use cookies when you are logged in so that we can remember this fact. This prevents you from having to log in every single time you visit a new page. These cookies are typically removed or cleared when you log out to ensure that you can only access restricted features and areas when logged in.
Email newsletters related cookies This site offers newsletter or email subscription services and cookies may be used to remember if you are already registered and whether to show certain notifications which might only be valid to subscribed/unsubscribed users.
Forms related cookies When you submit data to through a form such as those found on contact pages or comment forms cookies may be set to remember your user details for future correspondence.

Third Party Cookies

In some special cases we also use cookies provided by trusted third parties. The following section details which third party cookies you might encounter through this site.

This site uses Google Analytics which is one of the most widespread and trusted analytics solution on the web for helping us to understand how you use the site and ways that we can improve your experience. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site and the pages that you visit so we can continue to produce engaging content. Third party analytics are used to track and measure usage of this site so that we can continue to produce engaging content. These cookies may track things such as how long you spend on the site or pages you visit which helps us to understand how we can improve the site for you.

When we are still testing new features these cookies may be used to ensure that you receive a consistent experience whilst on the site whilst ensuring we understand which optimizations our users appreciate the most.
